On May 18th, 2019 at 9:52 pm, the Rock County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to a report of a vehicle runoff in the 14000 block of West Golf Air Drive in Union Township. Upon arrival, law enforcement located Martin C. Hull, 58, of Evansville, WI attempting to remove a 2013 Toyota Avalon from the ditch.

Upon contact with the driver, deputies observed signs of impairment and after administering standardized field sobriety tests, the arresting deputy found probable cause to arrest Mr. Hull for operating while intoxicated. A check through DOT records showed three prior OWI convictions, making this a felony 4th offense OWI. The Rock County Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Evansville Police Department during the investigation.

Hull was transported to the Rock County Jail, where he submitted to an evidentiary blood draw. The results of the blood draw are unknown at this time. Hull was booked into the Rock County Jail for the 4th offense OWI violation. Hull will attend Jail Court on 05/20/2019 at 3:00pm. Hull was also cited for Operating While Revoked.

Pursuant to the directive of the Wisconsin Supreme Court, as found in Supreme Court Rule 20:3.6, Trial Publicity, you are advised that a charge is merely an accusation and that a defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
