



**ROCK COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COORDINATING MOBILITY
SUB-COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
March 10, 2017**

Call to Order: The meeting of the Transportation Coordinating Committee, Mobility Sub-Committee was called to order at 8:04 a.m. at the Rock County Court House, 51 South Main Street, Janesville, Wisconsin.

Approval of Agenda: A motion to approve the agenda was made by T.J. Nee, seconded by Patty Hansberry. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: A motion to approve the January 13, 2017 minutes was made by T.J. Nee, seconded by Patty Hansberry. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Information on MTM: Ryan Booth discussed the MTM website that was sent out to members. He with with Jess Krueger about MTM's policies and procedures. He now has a better understanding of the process when people have issues.

Lynn Jones asked if Mr. Booth has heard any complaints from members. He has heard two. One was a client issue and the other is an ongoing issue for transportation to an out of state medical appointment.

T.J. Nee asked if the new person would be up to speed with the complaints that Rock County has had and were discussed with Dana Schulz. Committee members asked Mr. Booth to look at previous minutes to become familiar with what the issues have been and to be current on them.

Review Appendix 9 of the 2013 Plan: Mr. Booth had an affiliation list, however it was pointed out that Appendix 9 is actually a list of transportation within Rock County. Mr. Booth will follow up put on the agenda for the next meeting. Lynn Jones did ask that the affiliation list be cleaned up and be more reader friendly.

Supervisor Dommershausen advised HealthNet has come to the Human Services Board asking for help getting clients to clinics for appointments. Ryan Booth stated he left brochures and explained his services to the HealthNet Dental staff. HealthNet was closed at that time. The southwest part of the county, along with rural areas, are having transportation issues. Mr. Booth will follow-up with HealthNet. Lynn Jones suggested following up with the Director and Mr. Scharenbroch suggested educating them about services that members might get with MTM. Mr. Booth also spoke with MTM about how they could offer services to citizens who are not covered with state healthcare coverage.

Mr. Booth reported that the Rock County Transportation Resource Directory is being updated at this time. He also found that LaVigne Bus Company has a sub-station in Janesville by the Wisconsin School for the Visually Impaired.

Future Meeting Dates: The next meeting is scheduled for May 12, 2017.
