CST Outreach updates

The group met last month and identified areas where they plan to do some outreach. They will be contacting YSC staff, Crossroads and CPS staff. They are planning a training at the Building Successful Schools Conference in December. They will be meeting after the CST monthly meetings; everyone is welcome to attend.

Wellness & Recovery Empowerment Project (WREP)

They are in the process of formalizing their committee and looking into 501C3 status. They will have a booth at Paint the Town Yellow Suicide Prevention on October 1st, at Palmer Park.

CST Data Dashboard

There are currently 12 cases and 4 on a wait list.

TIC workgroup update

We are looking into having another training this fall and how to continue this into 2017.

The community therapists who participated in the 2015 training were invited to a one-day booster training in Madison recently. It was good to hear the impact that this training has had on their practice and their ability to serve youth in the community with a high level of trauma.

The trauma informed courts had a group go observe Milwaukee County courts. They've made some minor changes in our courtrooms to be more sensitive to client's needs.

Parent Support Group speaker possibilities

The BH supervisors talked about a parent support group and developing a process that would serve any client being served by BH. They also discussed the possibility of partnering with community agencies; however, they want to set the groundwork first before moving forward. We have money in the 2016 budget to have a speaker. We might offer a one-time training before the end of 2016, which would include a guest speaker. If you have suggestions for speakers please let Liane know.

CST committee appointments

We need one more parent member to join the CST Committee.

Winter event planning

We learned from the summer event that we need to start planning sooner for events so that we have time to seek donations from community agencies. We will start planning in late October or early November for the winter event. It would be helpful to have CST Committee members participate in planning and attending the events.

Newsletter ideas

We would like to go back to including artwork in the newsletters. The December newsletter will include summer event pictures. Some other ideas were to include an article on destressing over the holidays, and possibly having a spotlight article on the Fatherhood Initiative from Community Action. Lance will ask Subcare staff to contribute an article on Primary Care Teams.
