Slow-No-Wake Declared on Rock River

According to US Geological Survey Gauges, the water level for Afton is 10.08 feet. County Ordinance requires a slow-no-wake speed restriction be placed on the Rock River downstream of the W B R Town Line Road Bridge when water levels exceed 8.50 feet in Afton.

The Sheriff's Office is providing public notice of the Rock River's current slow-no-wake status. Deputies will begin placing slow-no-wake signs along the river at all public access points between the W B R Town Line Road Bridge and the Stateline.

At this time the Rock River is under a slow-no wake restriction south of the Indianford Dam.
