### **Motor Vehicle Crash and Stabbing in Newark Township**

On Sunday, 04/26/20, Rock County Sheriff's Office Deputies, along with Officers from Beloit Police Department and Town of Beloit Police Department, and a City of Janesville K-9 Officer responded to the area of S. Olson Rd and W. STH 81 in Newark Township for a possible motor vehicle crash and a possible stabbing.

Officers arrived on scene and located two adult males that sustained injuries which required medical treatment. Both individuals were transported via ambulance to Beloit Memorial Hospital where they were treated and released. A female, later identified as 21-year-old Alondra I. Gallardo F/H, had fled the scene on foot, possibly armed with a knife. A search of the area was conducted utilizing a K-9 track and drone; however, Gallardo was not located.

This incident remains under investigation and appears to be an isolated incident. The victims in this incident were both known by Gallardo; however, Patrol Deputies will continue to perform extra patrol duties in the Newark Township.
