On July 15, 2020, at 10:31 a.m., Deputies from the Rock County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Unit arrested 48-year-old, Daniel Robinson of Beloit, for 3 counts of Manufacture/Delivery of 1-5g of Cocaine and 1 count of Manufacture/Delivery of 5-15g of Cocaine, both felonies in the State of Wisconsin.

Robinson was already incarcerated at the Rock County Jail on unrelated charges and had his initial appearance in court on July 16, 2020. Robinson was issued a cash bond on these charges and is currently incarcerated at the Rock County Jail.
