Benefits Counseling

If you need accurate and current information about private and government benefits and programs to which you may be entitled, the ADRC of Rock County can assist you.

Our benefit specialists cut the red tape associated with Medicare, Medicaid, Social Security and other benefits. We can also answer your questions about public or private benefit programs or your legal rights.



Publicly funded programs

The ADRC is the entry-way to publicly funded long-term care programs. The ADRC will assess your level of need for services to determine if you are eligible. We can connect you to the following programs:
